Dear Mr. Bryant:

I have enjoyed the use and access of the beaches of Tiny Township for _____ years.

I am requesting your assistance in protecting the public's rights to continue the pattern of traditional use and access of Tiny's beaches which has taken place over the past 100 years.

Since the beginning of mediation, there has been an increase in restricting use and access, through the erection of private signs, gates and fences. Our municipal government has participated by using more restrictive 'no parking' policies (even in our municipal parks), blocking concession road ends with boulders, and placing signs on the beaches that show the delineation of municipally owned property, thereby misleading the public into believing their rights have been altered.

The mediation process has taken place almost entirely in private and the mediation efforts have resulted in the empowerment of waterfront stakeholders and further erosion of public rights.

If the public's rights are not protected by the Attorney General I fear the public's rights will be eliminated in many areas of Ontario.

The Attorney General must protect the rights of the public and if the Mediation process is not successful, I strongly request the Attorney General declare the beaches in Tiny Township public.
